IBRBS has strived to provide each member with opportunities to share our skills and mentoring. We maintained our support programs, including the eight Christmas School Scholarships and the three Higher Education Scholarships for both 2020 and 2021. The 2021 Educational Scholarship program is quickly coming to a close, so please take advantage of these \$500 awards to help offset some expenses for schooling. 

CELEBRATING RON ROBERTSON



Robertson, Ronald "Ron"

Ron was born on February 22, 1943, in San Francisco, CA, and passed away suddenly from a heart attack on January 20, 2021, in Mission Viejo, CA. He was born to Robert S. Robertson and Betty Suzanne Coy Robertson Fox. Ron is survived by his loving wife Barbara, married 38 years, sister Kimberley Fox- Spann, brother Gar Fox (deceased) (Pat), cousin John (Libby) Brady, sons Scott (Wendy) Edmunds and Bryan Edmunds, brother-in-law, George (Robyn) Danhoff, grandsons Harrison, Hayden, and Hudson Edmunds, and many nieces and nephews.

Ron spent his childhood living between the Bay area and Seattle. He attended Menlo-Atherton High School for 2 years then completed high school at King George V International School in Bangkok, Thailand. Returning to the States, he attended the Univ of WA, played Husky Football, and participated in Intercollegiate Wrestling Championships.

Ron enjoyed various careers including Sales, Civilian Ballistic Test Contractor at Fort Hunter Liggitt Army Base, Farming and Raising

Goats, Trucking, Restaurant Manager, and Electrical Contractor. His dream job was as Field Superintendent for tunnel-boring machines assembly in Germany, Australia, Great Britain, and Romania. He loved to travel and became a friend to many.

He returned to the States and settled in So. CA. He was a dedicated family man, attending every Sunny Hills High School football game and wrestling matches. He was an avid 49ers fan, enjoyed family vacations, and Sunday night movies.

In 1998 he joined the Clan Donnachaidh Society to pursue his Scottish heritage. He served the Clan as a Board member and truly enjoyed the camaraderie of fellow Scotts, participating in the annual Scottish games, dancing in his kilt at the Annual Scotsman's Ball, and "aye, sampling the haggis, along with a wee- bit of single malt".

In 2002 he joined a Santa group and worked as a Mall Santa for 5 years. As Santa Ron, he appeared in TV commercials, radio, and print ads. He co-founded the International Brotherhood of Real Bearded Santas (IBRBS) and served as its 1st President, later becoming a Board Director and President Emeritus.

Santa Ron was inducted into the 2014 International Santa Hall of Fame. He stood for excellence in the portrayal of Santa Claus among his fellow Santas and throughout the entire Santa community. He was a Santa for 18 years, bringing the Spirit of Christmas to all ages.

Santa Ron took his "Last Sleigh Ride" and is now resting peacefully in Heaven with his Creator. Due to COVID protocol, a Private Family Memorial was held on February 20th to toast, roast, and honor a Remarkable Man.



LEAVE MORE THAN JUST FOOTPRINTS

After experiencing 2014, it became obvious that when I am out in public, no matter how hard I try to disguise myself, the public recognizes me as Santa Claus. It doesn't matter what I'm wearing, where I am, or how hard I attempt to blend into the background, people spot me and the word spreads, "Santa Claus is in the building!" I finally gave up and surrendered my privacy. My decision was to embrace my alter ego and bring it out of the Christmas closet, permanently. From that day forth, I became Santa.

The first thing I did during my metamorphosis was to replace all my old "Clark Kent" clothes with casual Claus apparel. My newly emptied closet was quickly filled with Renaissance shirts (red, green, and white are my favorites), vests, jackets, and suspenders. There were several different styles of boots, numerous hats, and various Christmasthemed shirts. Santa was all set for 2015.

As it turned out, 2015 was a very special year. It marked our 25th anniversary. To celebrate, we wanted to go to someplace exotic. We honeymooned on Maui and loved Hawaii, so we started to search for possible destinations. We found a wonderful house we could rent on the Big Island (Hawaii). The Bamboo Guest House is located in a tropical rainforest at the secluded Volcano Rainforest Retreat. It was perfect and to say we were excited would be an understatement. We immediately booked it for a week and arranged for our airfare and a car rental. We were ready!

We forgot one thing. We had no idea what Santa Claus would do while he was on vacation or how he would act. I am confident when portraying Santa in my own community. I know the area, I know the people, and I know the customs. Our vacation was going to take us well outside of our comfort zone into the unknown. We had no idea of the Christmas customs we were about to encounter in crowded airports and from people isolated on an island three thousand miles away.

The Airport

Most people in an airport are focused on their destination and have no interest in the crowds that surround them. In order to prevent their becoming



overwhelmed and stressed, they typically do not make eye contact or interact with anyone. We quickly discovered that was not the case for Santa Claus. We were constantly greeted with waves, broad smiles, and "Hi, Santa!" People were also asking if they could take a picture. (Note: Although I was not wearing my Santa hat, I did have it in my briefcase in case there was a picture request.) While we were sitting at the gate waiting for departure, people continued to approach us to take pictures and share their own Christmas memories. During the six-hour flight, a dozen of the passengers either approached me for pictures or asked for one as I walked to the back of the plane. They were all smiling and excited about flying with Santa Claus. I had been concerned about how TSA would react to Santa, but they were great. They were all smiles, several took pictures, and usually would help me speed through the check-in process. The rental car staff were very excited to see us. Not only did they give us an amazing upgrade, but they also had all their staff come up to the desk and pose for pictures.

Mountain View Elementary is housed in buildings that had been used as an emergency hospital during WWII and it appeared there had been few if any improvements made to the facility since then. They met all our criteria for service. 85% of their 500 students are from low-income families and the school's reading scores are in the bottom half of all schools in Hawaii. We presented our proposal to the principal and she approved the project. Volcano Rotary identified two additional schools and negotiated with their principals. My nonprofit (PNA) agreed to fund the project. Our goal was to distribute 1,000 reading books to the students at the three target schools. I ordered the books and had them shipped to Mountain View, where they would be stored for us until the book fairs.

Bobbi and I returned to Hawaii in September 2017 to participate in our first free book fair at Mountain View. The theme was "Santa in September." The students would each get a picture with Santa and choose a book they would like to keep. The project

was a lot of fun. The teachers and students were very appreciative. Class by class filed through. Volcano Rotary took the pictures and worked at the book tables with



other volunteers. The community was aware that we had returned and quite a few people wanted to meet us and support the reading project. This was a complete success!

Update 2021

We have maintained contact with the friends we met in Hawaii. Strangers became friends who in turn became extended family. We have done free book fairs every year since 2017 with an annual goal of reaching 1,000 students. The Rotary Clubs of Tempe Rio Salado (AZ) and Volcano (HI) continue to work well together. Thanks to Zoom, they have been able to attend each other's meetings. In February 2021, they signed papers making them official "Sister Clubs."

Personally, we have been unable to make a return visit since 2017, but most definitely we will be back. I'm told the Bamboo House is waiting for us whenever we get there. We wanted to return in 2018, but Kilauea erupted destroying a large portion of the Southeast tip of the island. Our focus that year was to support several of the schools that

had been affected by the fierce lava flows. One school, which was a historic site, is now under 40 feet of lava. As much damage as the eruptions did to the



residents and economy of Hawaii, the free book fairs continued. In 2019, we had a previous commitment to be in Alaska that prevented our reunion on the Big Island, but the free book fairs continued. 2020 brought the pandemic and a year of isolation. Much of Hawaii was quarantined to the mainland, but the books shipped without a problem and the free book fairs continued. We already have the funding necessary for this year's book fairs and are looking at 2022 for our return to Volcano for an extended stay.

Bottom Line

Many environmental organizations urge tourists to "leave nothing but footprints." While that might be good advice, think about bringing your Santa Claus persona with you on vacation. You are blessed with the Magic of Christmas, a certain kind of power that helps people smile and laugh again. It's the ability to help people to talk, and to share, and to heal. Look around. These are all simple things that the world needs much more of and you have been given the gift of Claus. Don't hesitate to use it. We must leave more than just footprints.

Bamboo Guest House

We left the historic old harbor town of Hilo and headed out to our destination about 45 minutes away. The entire trip was up hill, as we climbed the side of the volcano and drove through the beautiful Fern Forest. Finally, we arrived at the Bamboo Guest House and it was nothing short of amazing. We checked in, unloaded the car, and relaxed as it had been a very long day and we were understandably exhausted. Fortunately, Bamboo House proved to be the perfect place for relaxation. Not only did both the interior and exterior of the house look like it had been featured in a fashion magazine, it was surrounded by dense tropical forest that was so thick, you could only see part of the driveway. We were alone in this beautiful place and enjoying the sounds of silence and birds chirping. To add to this Zen-like



experience, there was even a private Japanese soaking tub next to the house. We ate the fruit and muffins that were left for us and quickly fell asleep. We had to be up early in the morning to visit a local Rotary Club. I had been asked to speak at their meeting.

Rotary Club of Volcano Hawaii

At 6:30AM, we left for the Rotary meeting. Although they were only a few miles away, we wanted to make sure we arrived on time. Their meetings were held in the banquet room of the Volcano House Hotel. Established in 1866. the hotel is perched on the edge of the caldera of Kilauea, an active volcano that has been erupting constantly since 1983. Smoke rising from the crater is clearly visible through the huge windows covering one entire wall of the meeting room.

The subject of my talk was "Santa Claus as a

Community Leader." I discussed ways our nonprofit (PNA) has successfully used the Santa Claus theme to serve those in need and how we have frequently collaborated on these projects with my own Rotary Club. In fact, we have done this so much, my Rotary Club started using the nickname "The Santa Claus Rotary Club." At the end of my presentation, I gave each member of the Volcano Rotary Club a certificate making them an "Honorary Santa Claus." During a Question/Answer session, we discussed ways we could help Volcano Rotary achieve their service goals and help them develop new opportunities to serve their communities. These discussions have actively continued for the past six years now.

Return to the Big Island – 2017

The conversation about mutual service projects with the Volcano Rotary Club continued through 2016 and by early 2017, we had developed a plan. We decided to support reading proficiency by providing schools serving low-income families with free book fairs. I was in communication with a school I had spotted during our 2015 visit.

Santa 24 hours a day?

Santa would also encourage folks to go into the gallery and take a selfie with him. The selfie gallery was set up right around the corner from the magic TV and had a little magic of its own. Passengers could pose with a large monitor displaying a digital picture of Santa in various poses, with multiple props, and Santa talking directly to them.

Arriving passengers were surprised coming around the corner to see Santa and hearing him say, "Welcome to Asheville, North Carolina – hope you had a great flight!" Or you could



hear Santa saying, "Hey you, come on over and have a selfie with Santa!" Based on the smiles and expressions of the traveling public – it was a trip worth taking to see Santa!






